



ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Edward Walter, a citizen of the United States of America; residing at 123 Timber Mountain, Boerne, TX, 78006, USA; hereinafter called the "Assignor," has made the invention described in the United States patent application entitled "MODULAR NETWORK TERMINALS AND METHODS TO USE THE SAME," Attorney Docket No. 20103/2008-0164, for a full description of which reference is here made to an application for Letters Patent of the United States filed herewith; and

Assignors authorize attorney or agent to fill in the U.S. Application Serial No. above, if required.

AND said Assignors authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue Letters Patent on said application, and on any all divisions and continuations thereof, to said Assignee, its assigns and legal representatives, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
