Recitals

Whereas, Assignor sold certain assets to Assignee pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement, dated March 9, 2005 and intended to include in that sale all right, title and interest in and to the patent listed in Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Patent");

Whereas, the Asset Purchase Agreement omitted express reference to the Patent;

Whereas, Assignor desires to memorialize the transfer of assets to Assignee.

Patent Assignment

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby duly and fully acknowledged, effective as of March 9, 2005, Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over unto Assignee, its successors and assigns, absolutely and forever, the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent throughout the world and the inventions and designs covered thereby, including the right to claim priority and the right to any continuation, division, or substitute application thereof and the right to any reissue, restoration, extension or reexamination of any patents thereof, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee for its own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the end of the term for which the Patent has been or will be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor if this assignment had not been made; together with all claims by the Assignor for damages by reason of past infringement of the Patent with the right to sue for, and collect the same for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

Assignor shall timely execute and deliver any additional documents and perform such additional acts necessary or desirable to record and perfect the interest of Assignee in and to the Patent, and shall not enter into any agreement in conflict with this Assignment

No amendment, change or modification of this Assignment shall be effective unless set forth in writing and signed by the parties.

In the event that anyone or more provisions of this Assignment are deemed to be illegal or unenforceable, then the parties shall hereby request a tribunal, forum or court of competent jurisdiction to reform any such provision so as to make it enforceable while also maximizing the intent of the parties. If said provisions cannot be so modified, then such illegality or unenforceability will not affect any of the remaining legal and enforceable provisions hereof,


which will be continued as if the illegal and unenforceable provisions had not been inserted herein.

This Assignment may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.
