### ASSIGNMENT BY INVENTOR

Assignor warrants that Assignor has legal right and authority to assign the Rights, and that the Rights are unencumbered. Assignor also agrees to not sign any writing or do any act conflicting with this assignment.

Assignor authorizes Assignee to make application for such protection in its own name and maintain such protection in any and all countries foreign to the United States, and to invoke and claim for any application for patent or other form of protection for the Rights, without further authorization from Assignor, any and all benefits, including the right of priority provided by any and all treaties, conventions, or agreements.

Assignor hereby consents that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any document that may be required in any country as proof of the right of Assignee to apply for patents or other form of protection for the Rights and to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority.

Assignor requests that any and all patents for the Rights be issued to Assignee in the United States and in all countries foreign to the United States, or to such nominees as Assignee may designate.

Assignor hereby agrees that, when requested, he/she shall, without charge to Assignee, but at Assignee's expense, sign all papers, and do all acts that may be necessary, desirable or convenient in connection with the Rights or other obligations under this assignment, including to: perfect Assignee's enjoyment of the Rights; conduct proceedings regarding the Rights, including any litigation or interference proceedings; or perfect or defend title to the Rights.
