NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the undersigned, the undersigned does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto said Assignee, its successors and assigns, HHMI's entire right, title and interest throughout the world in and to said invention or inventions, as described in the aforesaid application, in any form or embodiment thereof, and in and to the aforesaid application; and in and to any application filed in any foreign country based thereon, including the right to file said foreign applications and claim priority under the provisions of any international convention or treaty; also the entire right, title and interest throughout the world in and to any and all patents or reissues or extensions thereof to be obtained in this or any foreign country upon said invention or inventions and any divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part or substitute applications which may be filed upon said invention or inventions in this or any foreign country; and the undersigned hereby authorizes

and requests the issuing authority to issue any and all patents on said application or applications to said Assignee or its successors and assigns.

The undersigned further agrees, without any further payment or compensation by said Assignee or its successors and assigns, to communicate to said Assignee, its representatives or agents or its successors and assigns, any facts relating to said invention or inventions including evidence for interference purposes or for other legal proceedings whenever requested; testify in any interference or other legal proceedings, whenever requested; execute and deliver, on request, all lawful papers required to make any of the foregoing provisions effective; and generally do everything possible to aid said Assignee, its successors or assigns and nominees to secure, obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention or inventions in this or any foreign country.



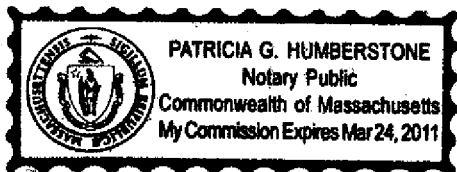

APPOINTMENT OF INVESTIGATOR AS AGENT

Appointment by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute (the "Institute") of Li-Huei Tsai, PhD, an employee of the Institute, as its agent for the purpose of assigning certain rights to The President and Fellows of Harvard College on behalf of Harvard Medical School (the "College").

WHEREAS, the Institute and the College collaborate in the active conduct of medical research pursuant to an Agreement between them dated as of January 1, 1986 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the Institute has agreed to assign to the College the Institute's rights with respect to inventions, discoveries, improvements, and other intellectual property, whether patentable or copyrightable (each a "Subject Property"), conceived or reduced to practice in the course of the research program conducted under the Agreement by employees of the Institute;

WHEREAS, research conducted pursuant to the Agreement by Li-Huei Tsai, PhD while employed by the Institute at the College has resulted in the invention of a certain Subject Property entitled "Resveratrol Enhances Learning and Memory in Mice," which is the subject of a patent application entitled "Improvement of Cognitive Performance with Sirtuin Activators" filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on June 14, 2005 with Serial Number 60/690,306, and the Invention is a Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Institute wishes Li-Huei Tsai, PhD to act as its agent for the purpose of assigning to the College the rights the Institute has in the Invention by reason of the research program conducted at the College,

NOW THEREFORE, the Institute hereby appoints Li-Huei Tsai, PhD as its agent for the purpose of assigning the rights the Institute has or may acquire in the Invention by reason of the research program conducted at the College to the College in accordance with and subject to the conditions of the Agreement.
