ASSIGNMENT

We, Rodney Rasmussen and Paul C. Cox, of 2149 South 2200 East, Salt Lake City, Utah 84105 and 5166 Spring Gate Drive, Salt Lake City, Utah 84117, respectively, have invented an invention entitled DRY POND WATER EVAPORATION SYSTEM AND METHOD OF EVAPORATING WATER hereinafter called the "invention."
