ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Stephen C. Jacobsen (resident of Salt Lake City, UT, whose postal mailing address is 274 S. 1200 East, Salt Lake City, UT 84102), David P. Marceau (resident of Salt Lake City, UT, whose postal mailing address is 1662 E. Princeton Ave., Salt Lake City, UT 84105), Shayne M. Zurn (resident of Salt Lake City, UT, whose postal mailing address is 2635 E. 2940 South, Salt Lake City, UT 84109), David T. 


