A S S I G N M E N T

ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT dated as of April 29, 2009 between Trustees of Dartmouth College, a New Hampshire nonprofit educational corporation established by Royal Charter having a place of business at 11 Rope Ferry Road, Hanover, New Hampshire 03755-1404 (hereinafter, "Assignor") and White Mountain Pharma, Inc., a New Hampshire corporation having a place of business at One New Hampshire Avenue, Suite 125, Portsmouth, New Hampshire 03801 (hereinafter "Assignee").

Whereas Assignor is the owner by assignment (i) recorded at Reel 9911, Frame 0553 of certain rights claimed in the United States Letters Patent No. 5,935,949, issued August 10, 1999, entitled Use of Androgen Therapy in Fibromyalgia and Chronic Fatigue Syndrome; (ii) recorded at Reel 0148848, Frame 0965 of certain rights claimed in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/677,673 filed on October 2, 2003, entitled "Compositions and Methods for Treatment of Muscle Pain and Muscle Wasting," (iii) recorded at Reel 018550, Frame 0812 of certain rights claimed in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 11/555,882 filed on November 2, 2006, entitled "Compositions and Methods for Treatment of Muscle Pain and Muscle Wasting," (iv) of any United States or foreign patents issuing from U.S. Patent Application Serial Nos. 10/677,673 and 11/555,882, and (v) any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, reexaminations or extensions of any of the above, data, and associated know-how, as developed by Dr. Hillary White (collectively "White Patent Rights");

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the said White Patent Rights;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration as set forth herein, and in Attachment I hereto, Assignor and Assignee agree as follows:

1. Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over, to Assignee, the entire right, title and interest in and to said White Patent Rights, and know-how (defined as laboratory and clinical records, raw data, clinical data, data analyses, test reports and evaluations, formulations used in clinical testing, pharmaceutical formulations, preclinical animal testing, and medical records pertaining to human clinical trials) relating to

the White Patent Rights, and any re-issue or extension of said White Patent Rights, the same to be held and enjoyed by said Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which said White Patent Rights are reissued or extended as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this assignment, sale and transfer not been made.

2. Assignor covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and have not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith, and further covenants and agrees that each time request is made and without undue delay, execute and deliver all such papers as may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said White Patent Rights to Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives, and agree to communicate to Assignee, or to its nominee all known facts respecting said White Patent Rights, to testify in any legal proceedings, to sign all lawful papers, to execute all disclaimers and reissues, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees and legal representatives to obtain and enforce for its or their own benefit proper patent protection.

3. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States to issue patents to Assignee, as Assignee of the entire right, title and interest to said White Patent Rights in accordance with the terms of this assignment.

4. Assignee covenants and agrees that it will not, at any time hereafter, either directly or indirectly, initiate, assign, maintain or prosecute, or in any way knowingly aid or assist in the initiation, maintenance or prosecution of any claim, demand, or cause of action at law or otherwise, against Assignor, its officers, agents, employees or members of its governing boards, for damages, loss or injury of any kind arising from or related to White Patent Rights assigned herein by Assignor.
