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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

This INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (this “**Agreement**”), dated as of May 8, 2009, is made by **SALIENT SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIES, INC.**, a Delaware corporation (“**Salient**”), and **SALIENT, INC.**, a Delaware corporation (“**Parent**”, and together with Salient, each a “**Grantor**” and together, the “**Grantors**”), in favor of **GENERAL ELECTRIC CAPITAL CORPORATION**, a Delaware corporation, as agent (the “**Agent**”), for the benefit of itself and certain Lenders (as defined below).

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement, dated as of April 30, 2008 (as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the “**Loan Agreement**”), between Grantors, Agent and the lenders signatory thereto from time to time (the “**Lenders**”), the Agent and Lenders have agreed to make extensions of credit to Salient upon the terms and subject to the conditions set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Loan Agreement and that certain First Amendment to Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement and Waiver, dated as of even date herewith, by and between Grantors, Agent and Lenders (the “**First Amendment**”), and in consideration of the amendments provided to Grantors thereunder, Grantors are required to execute and deliver this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained and to induce Agent and Lenders to enter into the First Amendment and to induce Lenders to continue to make extensions of credit to Salient under the Loan Agreement, Grantors hereby agree with Agent as follows:

Section 1. **Defined Terms.** Capitalized terms used herein without definition are used as defined in the Loan Agreement.

Section 2. **Grant of Security Interest in Intellectual Property Collateral.** Grantors, as collateral security for the prompt and complete payment and performance when due (whether at stated maturity, by acceleration or otherwise) of the Obligations hereby mortgage, pledge and hypothecate to Agent, for the benefit of Agent and Lenders, and grant to Agent, for the benefit of Agent and Lenders, a Lien on and security interest in, all of each Grantor’s right, title and interest in, to and under the following Collateral of such Grantor (the “**Intellectual Property Collateral**”):

(a) all of its trade secrets, inventions, designs, design rights, software and databases, licenses, customer lists and know-how and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use trade secrets, inventions, designs, design rights, software and databases, licenses, customer lists and know-how;

(b) all of its copyrights and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use copyrights, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 1 hereto, together with all renewals, reversions and extensions of the foregoing;

(c) all of its trademarks, tradenames, servicemarks and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use trademarks, tradenames or servicemarks, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 2 hereto, together with all renewals, reversions and extensions of the foregoing;

(d) all goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each such trademark, tradename or servicemark covered by (c) above;

(e) all of its US Patents and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use US patents, copyrights, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 3 hereto, together with all reissues, reexaminations, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, renewals and extensions of the foregoing;

(f) all of its US patent applications and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use US patent applications, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 4 hereto, together with all reissues, reexaminations, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, renewals and extensions of the foregoing;

(g) all of its foreign patents and patent applications, and rights under any written agreement granting any right to use foreign patents and patent applications patents, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 5 hereto, together with all reissues, reexaminations, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, renewals and extensions of the foregoing;

(h) all applications, registrations, claims, products, awards, judgments, amendments, improvements and insurance claims related thereto now or hereafter owned or licensed by each Grantor, or any claims for damages by way of any past, present, or future infringement of any of the foregoing, together with all accessions and additions thereto, proceeds and products thereof (including, without limitation, any proceeds resulting under insurance policies); provided, further, that the Intellectual Property Collateral shall include, without limitation, all cash, royalty fees, other proceeds, accounts and general intangibles that consist of rights of payment to or on behalf of each Grantor or proceeds from the sale, licensing or other disposition of all or any part of, or rights in, the Intellectual Property Collateral by or on behalf of each Grantor; and

(i) all income, royalties, proceeds and liabilities at any time due or payable or asserted under and with respect to any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, all rights to sue and recover at law or in equity for any past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, dilution, violation or other impairment thereof.

Section 3. Loan Agreement and First Amendment. The security interest granted pursuant to this Agreement is granted in conjunction with, and in no way limiting, the security interest granted to Agent, for the benefit of Agent and Lenders, pursuant to the Loan Agreement and the First Amendment, and Grantors hereby acknowledge and agree that the rights and remedies of Agent with respect to the security interest in the Intellectual Property Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Loan Agreement and the First

Amendment, the terms and provisions of each of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein.

Section 4. Grantors Remains Liable. Grantors hereby agree that, anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding, Grantors shall retain full and complete responsibility for the prosecution, defense, enforcement or any other necessary or desirable actions in connection with their Intellectual Property subject to a security interest hereunder.

Section 5. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Signature pages may be detached from multiple separate counterparts and attached to a single counterpart.


Section 6. Governing Law. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be governed by, and construed and interpreted in accordance with, the law of the State of New York.




