countries and all reissues, extensions, renewals, divisions and continuations thereof, to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent may be issued, to be held and enjoyed by the said National University Corporation Hokkaido University, its successors and assigns the same as it would have been held and enjoyed by Hokkaido Technology Licensing Office Co., Ltd., if this assignment and sale had not been made.

AND, Hokkaido Technology Licensing Office Co., Ltd., hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue all such Letters Patents to the said National University Corporation Hokkaido University, in accordance with this instrument of assignment.

Hokkaido Technology Licensing Office Co., Ltd., hereby represents and warrants that there are no rights or interests outstanding inconsistent with the rights and interests granted herein and that Hokkaido Technology Licensing Office Co., Ltd., will not execute any instrument or grant or transfer any rights or interests inconsistent therewith, and Hokkaido Technology Licensing Office Co., Ltd., binds itself and its heirs, executors, administrators, employees and legal representatives, as the case may be, to execute and deliver to the said National University Corporation Hokkaido University, its successors and assigns, any further documents or instruments and do any and all further acts that may be deemed necessary by the said National University Corporation Hokkaido University, its successors and assigns to file applications for the said improvements and invention in any country where it may elect to file such applications, and that may be necessary to vest in the said National University Corporation Hokkaido University, its successors and assigns, the title herein conveyed, or intended so to be, and to enable such title to be recorded in the United States and foreign countries where such application or applications may be filed.


