Hereby:

1. Assigns, transfers and conveys to AREVA, having an office at Tour AREVA, 1 place de la Coupole, 92400 Courbevoie France, (hereinafter referred to as "the Assignee"), the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and discoveries, said application and Letters Patent of the United States of America, any and all other applications for Letters Patent on said inventions and discoveries worldwide, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, and Convention applications based in whole or in part upon said inventions or discoveries, or upon said applications, and any and all Letters Patent, reissues, and extensions of Letters Patent granted for said inventions and discoveries or upon said applications, and every priority right that is or may be predicated upon or arise from said inventions, said discoveries, said applications, and said Letters Patent including the right to damages for past infringement.

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or all of said inventions and discoveries in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem appropriate, under the International Convention or otherwise.

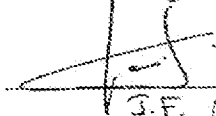

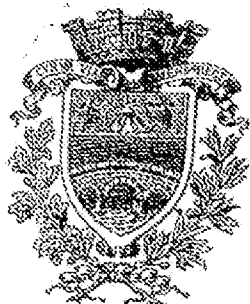

"Monsieur Bernard Bled, Directeur Général de l'E.P.A.D., saisi par Christian Bouvier, ancien directeur l'établissement public, propose de rendre hommage à l'ingénieur urbaniste Jean Millier, polytechnicien attribuant son nom à la place de la Coupole. Le siège de l'E.P.A.D. était localisé dans l'actuelle tour Areva : Jean Millier le dirigeait de 1969 à 1977. Il a plus précisément initié la première relance du quartier d'af dans les années 1970. Pour sa part, l'E.P.A.D. prend en charge l'aspect administratif de cette décision.

The Mayor sets out:

"Mr. Bernard Bled, General Director of the E.P.A.D., seized by Christian Bourvier, former Director of the public establishment, suggests paying homage to the town planner engineer Jean Millier, former student of the "Ecole Polytechnique" by attributing his name to the square named "place de la Coupole". The head office of the E.P.A.D. was located in the current Areva tower when Jean Millier managed it from 1969 to 1977. He has more exactly introduced the first stimulation of the business district in the 70's. As far as he is concerned, the E.P.A.D. takes in charge the administrative aspect of this decision.

THE TOWN COUNCIL,

The preamble of the file being agreed,

Whereas the general code of the territorial collectivities and, in particular the article L 2121-29,

Whereas the opinion of the environment, heritage and town planning commission gathered on November 12, 2007.

After having deliberating, unanimously (with 11 proxy votes),

DECIDES:

- to reappoint the square named "place de la Coupole" located at La Défense: "place Jean Millier"
