## PATENT APPLICATION ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT APPLICATION ASSIGNMENT is effective nunc pro tunc as of July 1, 2007 (the "Assignment") between M Management-Tex, Ltd., a Texas Limited Partnership ("Assignor"), and M Management-Tex, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the United States patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule A, documentary evidence of which is recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (the "Patent Property");

WHEREAS, Assignee has agreed to contribute all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent Property;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. Assignor sells, conveys, transfers, assigns and delivers to the Assignee and its successors and assigns all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent Property including, without limitation, the inventions embodied therein, all reissues, reexaminations, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, and U.S. and foreign corresponding patents that may issue therefrom, and all renewals and extensions of any of them. Assignor further sells, conveys, transfers, assigns and delivers to the Assignee, any right to recover for past and future infringement of the Patent Property assigned herein.

2. Cooperation and Recordation. Assignor hereby agrees to cooperate with Assignee as reasonably necessary to give full effect to and to perfect the rights of the Assignee in the Patent Property. Assignor agrees to execute and deliver such other documents and to take all such other actions as the Assignee, its successors and assigns may reasonably request to effect the terms of this Assignment and to execute and deliver any and all affidavits, testimonies, declarations, oaths, samples, exhibits, specimens and other documentation as may be reasonably required to effect the terms of this Agreement. Assignor agrees that Assignee may record this Assignment in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and such other offices foreign to the United States as the Assignee deems necessary, and shall be responsible for all expenses and costs associated therewith.

3. Governing Law. This Assignment shall be construed by and governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law provision or rule that would cause the application of laws of any jurisdictions other than the State of Texas.

4. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, and by the different parties hereto in separate counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Assignment by facsimile shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart to this Assignment.

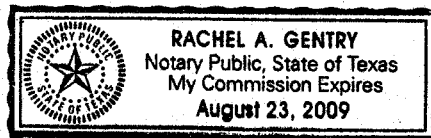
