certificates and designs which may be granted for the invention in any country or countries

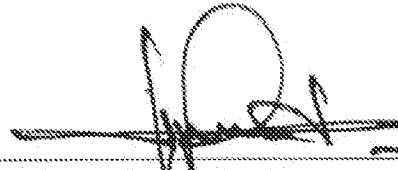
