2. Parent shall not assume, nor shall Parent have assigned, transferred or conveyed to it, any liability or obligation of Subsidiary whatsoever, whether pursuant to this Transfer and Assignment or otherwise.

3. From time to time after the date hereof, Subsidiary shall execute and deliver such documents and take such actions, including without limitation regarding any governmental registration office, as Parent reasonably requests in connection with carrying out and effectuating the intent and purpose hereof and all transactions and undertakings contemplated hereby. If any provision or application of this Transfer and Assignment is held unlawful or unenforceable in any respect, this Transfer and Assignment shall be revised or applied in a manner that renders it lawful and enforceable to the fullest extent possible.
