ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS



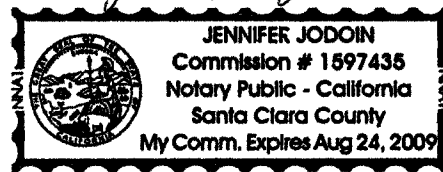
