
ASSIGNMENT

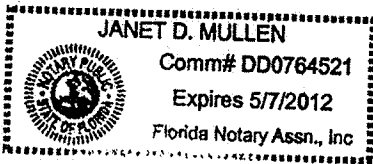


