

## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

We, ROGER V. BOSTELMAN, residing in FREDERICK, MARYLAND, and JAMES S. ALBUS residing in KENSINGTON, MARYLAND invented "HOME LIFT POSITION AND REHABILITATION (HLPR) APPARATUS", and have filed an application for United States Letters Patent, Serial Number 12/336,154 on December 16, 2008.


