## PATENT ASSIGNMENT

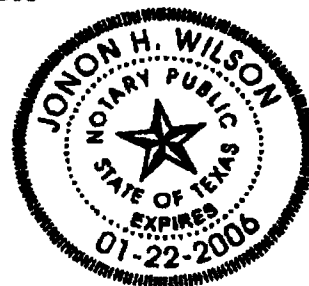
