AND Assignor acknowledges an obligation of assignment of said invention(s) to Assignee at the time said invention(s) was/were made.


ALSO, Assignor hereby agrees to execute any documents that legally may be required in connection with the filing, prosecution and maintenance of said Patent Application or any other patent application(s) or inventor certificate(s) in the United States and in foreign countries for said invention(s), including additional documents that may be required to affirm the rights of Assignee in and to said invention(s), all without further consideration. ALSO, Assignor agrees, without further consideration and at Assignee's expense, to transfer the right to sue for past infringement to Assignee and at Assignee's request documents and information concerning the enforcement of the right to sue within Assignor's possession or control, and to provide further assurances and testimony on behalf of Assignee that lawfully may be required of Assignor in respect of the right to sue of any patent encompassed within the terms of this instrument.



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


