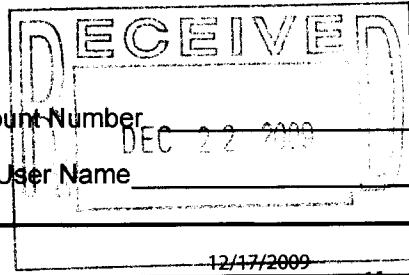

Whereas I an undersigned inventor have invented certain new and useful improvements as set forth in the patent application entitled:


