ASSIGNMENT

Whereas, we, Douglas H. Murdoch of 2060 Woodside Drive, Santa Rosa, CA 95404, and Michael Sturm of 17805 Western Way, Redding, CA 96003, have invented certain new and useful articles identified as

1. a "Carrier System," the U.S. provisional application no. 60/742,294 for which was filed on December 5, 2005, the international application PCT/US 2006/061357 for which was filed on November 29, 2006, and subsequently entered national phase as the U.S. Non-Provisional Application 12/095,997 on June 3, 2008; and

2. a "Carrier for Photographic Equipment," the U.S. provisional application no. 60/904,603 for which was filed on March 1, 2007, the international application PCT/US 2008/055194 for which was filed on February 27, 2008, and subsequently entered national phase as the U.S. Non-Provisional Application 12/529,141 on August 28, 2009.

(The articles and the non-provisional U.S. applications identified above will be referred to below collectively as the "Inventions" and the "Applications," respectively.)

Now, therefore, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, by these presents, confirm that effective on the filing dates of provisional applications 60/742,294 and 60/904,603, respectively, we sold, assigned, and transferred to Assignee our entire right, title, and interest in the respective Inventions and modifications and improvements of the Inventions, the respective Applications, including any non-provisional applications, divisions, continuations, and continuations-in-part claiming any priority therefrom, and in and to any and all patents of the United States of America and countries foreign thereto, which may be granted for the Inventions and for modifications and improvements of the Inventions, and in and to any and all priority rights, Convention rights, and other benefits accruing or to accrue to us with respect to the filing of applications for patents or securing of patents for the Inventions and modifications and improvements of the Inventions in the United States of America and counties foreign thereto.

We hereby authorize and request the Commissioner for Patents to issue said United States patents to the Assignee (or to its assignees or other successors in interest), as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest in and to the same, for its sole use and benefit, to the full end
