## ASSIGNMENT

Storm Technologies, Inc. is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina and has a place of business at 411 North Depot Street, Albemarle, NC 28002, and

Richard F. Storm is an individual resident of the State of North Carolina having a place of business at 411 North Depot Street, Albemarle, NC 28002, and is also CEO of Storm Technologies, Inc., and

Storm Technologies, Inc. and Richard F. Storm are collectively referred to herein as ASSIGNOR, and

ASSIGNOR owns certain inventions and improvements disclosed in the patent applications and patents (collectively, the "INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES") listed on Exhibit A hereto, and

The SEFA Group, Inc. is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and has a place of business at 217 Cedar Road, Lexington, South Carolina 29073 ("ASSIGNEE"), and is desirous of acquiring the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of Five Dollars (\$5.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR hereby represents and warrants to ASSIGNEE that: (i) ASSIGNOR owns all right, title and interest in and to the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES; (ii) ASSIGNOR has not assigned, licensed, leased, or otherwise granted or conveyed to any other person (other than those constituting ASSIGNOR) any right, title or interest in or to the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES; and (iii) ASSIGNOR does not know, and does not have any reason to suspect, that any other person claims, may claim, or may have any right to claim, any interest in or to the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES.

For the same consideration, ASSIGNOR by these presents does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto ASSIGNEE the full, exclusive and entire right, title, and interest in and to said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, in and to any divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and reissues thereof, said divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and reissues being included in and part of said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES whether or not listed in Exhibit A, and in and to all inventions and improvements disclosed and described in said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, including all rights ASSIGNOR may have to sue for damages and other remedies

in respect of any infringement of the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES which may have occurred before the date of this ASSIGNMENT.

ASSIGNOR hereby requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent of the United States resulting from said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, or from any divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reexamination, or reissue thereof, to ASSIGNEE, as the assignee, for its interest and for the sole use and benefit of ASSIGNEE and its assigns and legal representatives.

For the same consideration, ASSIGNOR, by these presents does hereby sell, assign, and transfer to ASSIGNEE, the full, exclusive, and entire right, title and interest in and to any and all patents and patent applications issued, filed, or which may be filed as a Patent Cooperation Treaty patent application, as any other type of international patent application, as a regional patent application, or in countries other than the United States, which correspond to any of said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES or claim priority of or to any of said INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES in whole or in part (collectively, the "CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES"), in and to any Letters Patent and similar protective rights granted on said CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, and in and to the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations; all said CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES to be filed and issued in the name of ASSIGNEE, or its designee, insofar as permitted by applicable law.



AND, for the same consideration, ASSIGNOR agrees, without charge to ASSIGNEE but at its expense, to sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reexamination, reissue and other applications, make all assignments and rightful oaths, be joined with the ASSIGNEE as a nominal party if necessary to satisfy any requirement of law in any proceeding in respect of infringement, invalidity, or priority of invention, of any of the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES or CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, and generally do everything reasonably possible to aid ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and nominees, to obtain and enforce proper protection for all said inventions, improvements, INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, and CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES, in all countries throughout the world.

ASSIGNOR further agrees that all records of ASSIGNOR which establish, indicate, or evidence inventorship, ownership, priority of invention, or dates of invention, including but not limited to dates of conception and dates of reduction to practice, are hereby the property of ASSIGNEE and will be made available at no additional charge to ASSIGNEE in the event such records are needed or desirable in connection with any of the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES or CORRESPONDING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES. If ASSIGNOR has a policy under which aged records are destroyed, or ASSIGNOR determines that ASSIGNOR has no need of such records, then ASSIGNOR will send such records to ASSIGNEE, at no charge to ASSIGNEE, instead of destroying such records.

ASSIGNEE, by these presents, does hereby grant to Storm Technologies, Inc. a fully-paid, non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited license under the INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES only for, and specifically limited to, the processing of solely organic waste and biomass which has not been previously combusted; the right to process mineral matter and previously combusted material, such as but not limited to fly ash, is expressly excluded under this limited license. Storm Technologies, Inc. acknowledges and agrees to these limitation in this limited license.

This ASSIGNMENT is effective against, and binding on, ASSIGNOR as of the date set forth below, regardless of whether or not ASSIGNEE signs, or later signs, this ASSIGNMENT.
