ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Klaus-Günter Eberle and Roland Biset, (hereinafter "Assignors") have invented certain new and useful improvement in

CARTRIDGE AND CENTRIFUGE HAVING A CARTRIDGE

(hereinafter "invention") for which a LETTERS PATENT OF THE UNITED STATES has been filed on December 3, 2009 as Serial No. 12/602,952.

And Assignors do hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S.A., to issue said U.S. LETTERS PATENT, when granted, in accordance with this assignment.


