In accordance with the Code of Alabama, 1975, the following articles of merger are submitted.

1. The name of the surviving corporation is: Degussa Corporation
2. The plan of merger is as follows: SIVENTO Inc., an Alabama corporation and a wholly owned subsidiary of Degussa Corporation, will be merged with and into Degussa Corporation, an Alabama corporation, with Degussa Corporation surviving the merger. At the effective time of the merger, 12:05 am January 1, 2003, all outstanding shares of SIVENTO Inc. will be canceled and no consideration will be paid for such shares. Degussa Corporation will assume all of the obligations and liabilities of SIVENTO Inc. The merger shall be deemed to have occurred immediately after the merger of CREAMOVA Inc., a Delaware corporation, with and into Degussa Corporation.
3. The number of shareholder votes required, their designation, number of outstanding shares, number of votes to be cast by each voting group and the number of votes cast for and against the plan:
4. The number of votes cast for the plan by each voting group was sufficient for approval by the voting group.
5. Shareholder approval was not required.
6. Immediately before the merger, the parent corporation owned at least 80% of the outstanding shares of each class of the subsidiary.
7. The county where the articles of incorporation for each domestic corporation involved in the merger is filed: The Articles of Incorporation for Degussa Corporation, the surviving Alabama corporation, were filed in the County of Mobile, State of Alabama. The Articles of Incorporation of SIVENTO Inc., the Alabama corporation to be merged into Degussa Corporation, were filed in the County of Montgomery, State of Alabama.
