WHEREAS, David Ray Hurst, an inventor of the invention entitled "CONCRETE PUMP PRIMER," executed an assignment on January 18, 2005 transferring rights to the invention and to U.S. Provisional Application Serial No. 60/537,701 to Prime-A-Pac, Inc.;

WHEREAS, as of January 18, 2005, Prime-A-Pac, Inc. had all rights, title and interest to the invention for the "CONCRETE PUMP PRIMER";

WHEREAS, a subsequent international patent application was filed on January 19, 2005 for the "CONCRETE PUMP PRIMER" and was assigned Application No. PCT/US05/01980, and a U.S. patent application was filed as a national stage application of the international application on June 26, 2006 and assigned Application Serial No. 10/584,673;

WHEREAS, effective October 19, 2006, Prime-A-Pac, Inc. changed its name to Enviro-Systems, Inc.;

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to this invention in all countries throughout the world, and in and to the applications for United States Letters Patent on this invention and the Letters Patent to be issued upon this application;



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
