## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

This Assignment of Patent Application is by and between Baron Services, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignee"), and the undersigned inventors.

WHEREAS, the undersigned inventors previously assigned to Baron Services, Inc., an Alabama corporation, its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, the entire right, title, and interest, for all countries in and to certain patent applications and inventions relating to

as described in a Patent Application filed on February 10, 1998 as Application Serial No. 09/021,449, and any and all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, and renewals of and substitutes for said application and their equivalents in U.S. and/or foreign jurisdictions, all applications claiming priority to or the benefit of said applications, including patent applications filed in U.S. and/or foreign jurisdictions or under any international convention, and all the rights and privileges under any and all Patent that may be granted therefore in any country, and any reissues, or reexaminations, or extensions of patent granted from any of the above and their equivalents in any jurisdiction, including but not limited to U.S. Patent 6,188,960 ("Patent Rights");

WHEREAS, Baron Services, Inc., an Alabama corporation, assigned its entire right, title, and interest in the Patent Rights to Baron Services, Inc., a Delaware corporation;

WHEREAS, the assignment from the undersigned inventor to Baron Services, Inc., an Alabama corporation, cannot be located;

WHEREAS, this Assignment of Patent Application is being executed to confirm the original assignment from the undersigned inventors, and the current ownership of the Patent Rights by Assignee;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the undersigned inventors agree as follows:

1. The undersigned inventors confirm that, on or about February 10, 1998, for good and valuable consideration, they agreed to assign and did thereby sell, assign and transfer unto Baron Services, Inc., an Alabama corporation, and its successors, assigns and legal representatives, the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights on or about February 10, 1998.
2. To the extent that there is any issue with such confirmation or such assignment is deemed ineffective for any reason, then the undersigned inventors do hereby assign, convey, transfer and deliver to Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the Patent Rights to Assignee.
3. Further, I/we request that any and all Patents issuing from said applications be issued to said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, or to such nominees as it may designate.
4. I/We agree that, when requested, we will, without charge to said Assignee but at its expense, sign all papers, take all rightful oaths, and do all acts which may be necessary, desirable or convenient for securing and maintaining patents for said inventions in any and all countries and for vesting title thereto in said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees.
5. I/We authorize and empower said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees, to invoke and claim for any application for patent or other form of protection for said inventions filed by it or them, the benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the

Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, and to invoke and claim such right of priority without further written or oral authorization from us.

6. I/We hereby consent that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document which may be required in any country for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of said Assignee or nominee to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.

7. I/We covenant with said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, that the rights and property originally conveyed to Baron Services, an Alabama corporation, were free and clear of any encumbrance, and that we had the full right to convey same as herein expressed, and further that to the extent that such rights were not originally transferred to Baron Services, an Alabama corporation, that such rights and property conveyed to Assignee herein are free and clear of any encumbrance.
