ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, William Allison, residing at 4243 NW Chaparral Terrace, Beaverton, OR 97006; Ping Huang, residing at 3025 Virginia Ave. S, Apartment 20, St. Louis Park, MN 55420; Diane Scott, residing at 3140 NE Bryce Street, Portland, Oregon 97212; Richard Frentzel, 31900 Serrento Avenue, Murrieta, CA 92563 and Robert Kerprich, NW Jewell Lane, Portland, Oregon 97229 have invented certain new and useful improvements in CMP Pad With Local Area Transparency for which we have filed have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States on January 13, 2010 under Serial No. 12/657135; and

WHEREAS, NexPlanar Corporation, organized under the laws of Delaware, is desirous of obtaining the entire right, title, and interest in, to and under the said improvements and the said application;

AND WE HEREBY covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to said NexPlanar Corporation, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid the said NexPlanar Corporation, its successors, legal representatives and assigns to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.

AND WE HEREBY further assign and transfer to NexPlanar Corporation all priority rights derived from such application therefore by virtue of the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property for any and all member countries of the aforesaid International convention and we do hereby assign and transfer to NexPlanar Corporation the sole right to file further applications for patents under the patent laws of any country of the world based on any improvements disclosed in said application as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had this assignment not been made.

AND NEXPLANAR CORPORATION HEREBY assumes all right, title, and interest in and to this application and the improvements disclosed therein, any Letters Patents or reissues or reexamined patents that may be granted upon said application, to the end of the term or terms for which such Letters Patent are or may be granted or reissued or reexamined.






