ASSIGNMENT

patent may be granted in this or any foreign country, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by me had this assignment and sale not been made, and covenant that I have full right so to do, and agree that I will communicate to the State of Oregon acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education on behalf of Portland State University, or its successors and assigns, any facts known to me respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths, and do everything possible to aid the State of Oregon acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education on behalf of Portland State University, its successors and assigns to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention in this or any foreign country.
