ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) each in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the Assignors, the Assignors by these presents do grant, sell, assign and transfer unto Assignee their entire and exclusive right, title and interest in and to all of said Technology, patent applications, priority rights, patents, and right to sue for and be awarded all remedies (all of the foregoing hereinafter referred to, individually and collectively, as the "Transferred Rights And Things"); said Transferred Rights And Things to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and for its assigns, transferees, successors and legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the Transferred Rights And Things would have

been held by Assignors had this Assignment Agreement not been made. One of the patent applications subject to this Assignment Agreement is the patent application above identified by filing date and serial number.

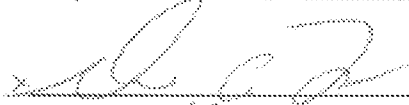
Assignors request that all of said Letters Patent be issued to Assignee as assignee of the entire interest therein.

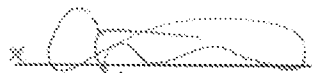
