ALBIS a producer of nonwoven fabrics and Oerlikon Neumag a branch of OTX a producer of machineries for the man-made fiber market had have a cooperation for a development for stacking synthetic fibres to form a nonwoven. The results of the past development lead to a joint invention titled "Device for stacking synthetic fibres to form a nonwoven". Called inventors of this invention are the President of ALBIS Mr. Boscolo and OTX employee Mr. Heesch.

The invention was applied for a patent application in Germany on behalf of Saurer GmbH & Co.KG, the former name of OTX with filing date 24.09.2004 and file no. 102004046309.3. The German patent application was lapse due of a following international patent application filed under PCT/EP2005/010308 (WO2006023517 A1) during priority term, which leads to a pending Chinese patent application No. 2005 800 32320.4 and a pending U.S. patent application No. 11/575,843, wherein OTX is the present registered owner.

Now the parties agree as follow:

1. ALBIS makes a payment of 15.000,-- Euro for the past costs for the Chinese patent application and the U.S. patent application directly to Oerlikon Neumag.
2. In opposite OTX assigns the Chinese patent application No. 2005 800 32320.4 and the U.S. patent application No. 11/575,843 to ALBIS as sole proprietor of patent. Here-with ALBIS accept the assignment.
3. ALBIS will bear all cost and fees due of the patent assignment and due of maintaining the Chinese patent application and the U.S. patent application.
4. Both parties are entitled to make use of the invention in China and USA. But only ALBIS has the right to assign and to grant licenses to third parties in China and USA. ALBIS is willing for a case by case license agreement with OTX, if OTX will supply the patented technology to a third party in China or USA. OTX is willing to pay royalties to ALBIS for such license agreement.
5. This agreement shall start with signing of the parties and shall run for an undefined time and at the latest ends with expiry, refusal or withdrawal of patents/ patent applications.
6. Should any provision of this agreement be invalid or unenforceable or should the contract contain an omission, the remaining provisions shall be valid. In the place of an invalid provision, a valid provision is presumed to be agreed upon by the parties, which comes economically closest to the one actually agreed upon; the same shall apply in the case of an omission.
7. This agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the Federal Republic of Germany.
The parties shall make a diligent effort to settle amicably all disagreements in conjunction with this contract. If an amicable agreement is not reached the disputes shall

be finally settled under the Rules of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with said Rules. Arbitration proceeding shall be conducted in Düsseldorf, Germany, in English.


