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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, **Roger A. O'Neill**, a resident of **San Carlos, California**; **Marc Glazer**, a resident of **Mountain View, California**; and **Tom Weisan Yang**, a resident of **Cupertino, California** (hereinafter termed "Inventors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in **METHODS AND DEVICES FOR ANALYTE DETECTION**, for which invention they have executed a United States utility patent application, having Serial Number 11/185,247, and filing date of July 19, 2005, and which invention is fully described in the specification pertaining to said application.



interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of said applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any said patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said invention and any applications therefor and any patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Inventors in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Inventors, their respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

4. Said Inventors hereby warrant and represent that they have not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.

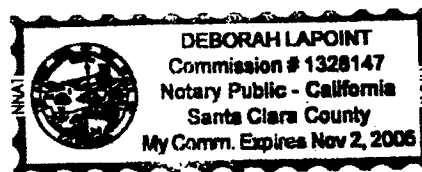

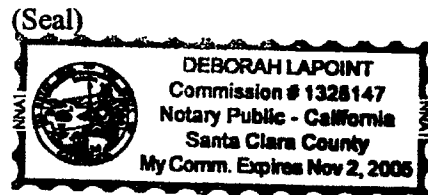

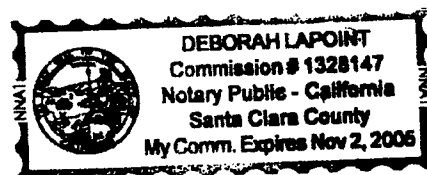
