

**RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN
PATENTS AND PATENT APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, GRLC LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Debtor") granted a security interest in and lien upon certain patents and related rights to Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, successor by merger to Wachovia Bank, National Association ("Secured Party") as set forth in the Patent Trademark Collateral Assignment and Security Agreement, dated as of June 26, 2009, by and between Debtor and Secured Party (the "Patent Security Agreement");

1. releases and reassigns to Debtor any and all liens, security interests, right, title and interest of Secured Party pursuant to the Patent Security Agreement in: (a) all of Debtor's now existing or hereafter acquired right, title, and interest in and to all of Debtor's interest in any patents and all applications, registrations and recordings relating to the foregoing as may at any time be filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or in any similar office or agency of the United States of America, any State thereof, any political subdivision thereof or in any other country, including, without limitation, those patents, applications, registrations and recordings described in Exhibit A hereto, together with all rights and privileges arising under applicable law with respect to Debtor's use of any patents and all reissues, divisions, continuations, extensions and renewals thereof (all of the foregoing being collectively referred to herein as the "Patents"); (b) all present and future inventions and improvements described and claimed therein; (c) all income, fees, royalties and other payments at any time due or payable with respect thereto, including, without limitation, payments under all licenses at any time entered into in connection therewith; (d) the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof; (e) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world; and (f) any and all other proceeds of any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, all damages and payments or claims by Debtor against third parties for past or future infringement of the Patents, without recourse or representation or warranty, express or implied, of any kind;

2. agrees that any power of attorney or similar rights granted by Debtor to Secured Party pursuant to or in connection with the Patent Security Agreement is terminated; and

3. authorizes and requests that the United States Patent and Trademark Office note and record the existence of the release hereby given.
