**NUNCPRO TUNC PATENT INVENTION
AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT**

This Assignment, dated May 26, 2010, is entered into, *nunc pro tunc*, effective April 2, 2007, by B.J. industries, inc., a Minnesota corporation located at 2900 Wind Cave Court, Burnsville, Minnesota, 55337 ("Assignor") and Accessible Systems, LLC a Minnesota limited liability company located at 2950 Weeks Avenue SE, Minneapolis, MN 55414 ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of all right, title and interest in the patents listed on **Schedule A** attached hereto, including, but not limited to, all rights directly or indirectly related to the Patents and the contents thereof; such as rights in any inventions, trade secrets or other intellectual property related thereto (collectively, the "Patents");

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring all right, title and interest in and to said Patents;

WHEREAS, Assignor (as seller) and Assignee (as purchaser) have entered into that certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated April 2, 2007 (hereafter, the "APA"), which agreement is incorporated herein by reference and is made a part hereof, wherein Assignor agreed to sell, and Assignee agreed to purchase, the Patents on the terms described therein and subject to the terms of the parties' Patent Security Agreement dated April 2, 2007, (hereafter, the "Patent Security Agreement") and the parties' Security Agreement dated April 2, 2007, (hereafter, the "Security Agreement") both of which, are also incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to transfer and assign to Assignee, and Assignee desires to accept the transfer and assignment of, all right, title, and interest in, to and under the Patents in and throughout the United States of America, its territories and all foreign countries, including the right to claim priority under United States law, any applicable foreign country's law, or international convention, and all provisionals, non-provisionals, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, reissues, reexaminations, renewals, substitutes and extensions of any of the foregoing.

NOW, THEREFORE, as of the effective date written above, Assignor, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby transfer and assign to Assignee, and Assignee hereby accepts the transfer and assignment of, all right, title, and interest in, to, and under the Patents in and throughout the United States of America, its territories and all foreign countries, including the right to claim priority under United States law, any applicable foreign country's law, or international convention, and all provisionals, non-provisionals, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, reissues, reexaminations, renewals, substitutes and extensions of any of the foregoing, all rights to sue for past, present and future infringements, whether arising prior to or subsequent to the date of this Assignment, together with all causes of action and the right to collect damages and costs for all past, present and future infringements, the same to be held and enjoyed by the said Assignee, its Successors and assigns, from and after the effective date above, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this Assignment not been made.

IN ADDITION, Assignor covenants and agrees to execute or cause execution of any further assurance of title to any of the Patents or inventions described therein, and to, at any time, upon the request of Assignee deliver, or cause to be delivered, and execute, or cause to be executed, all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said inventions or any patent which may be granted therefore in Assignee, its successors, assigns or any other legal representatives and will make, or cause to be made, all rightful oaths, or declarations, and do all lawful acts requisite for procuring the same therein, without further compensation.

NOTWITHSTANDING anything contained herein to the contrary, the transfer and assignment made by Assignor to Assignee is nevertheless made subject to the terms and conditions of the parties' APA, Patent Security Agreement and Security Agreement, and to the extent anything contained in this document shall be deemed to be contrary to or otherwise in conflict with any of the terms and conditions of the parties' APA, Patent Security Agreement and Security Agreement, then, in such case the terms and conditions of the parties' APA, Patent Security Agreement and Security Agreement shall control.
