

ASSIGNMENT AND SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE

THIS ASSIGNMENT AND SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE is effective as of July 27, 2009, from Connecticut Innovations, Inc., a specially chartered Connecticut corporation formerly known as the Connecticut Product Development Corporation, having its principal place of business at 200 Corporate Place, 3rd Floor, Rocky Hill, CT 06067 (hereinafter "CII") to Gunther International, Ltd., a Delaware corporation, having its principal place of business at One Winnenden Road, Norwich, CT 06360 (hereinafter "Gunther").

WHEREAS, Gunther executed and delivered to CII a certain Security Agreement dated April 9, 1987 granting to CII a security interest in certain patents and patent applications of Assignor (the "1987 Security Agreement"), which 1987 Security Agreement was filed with the United States Patent & Trademark Office on May 26, 1987 in Reel 4727 beginning at Frame 0191;

WHEREAS, Gunther executed and delivered to CII a certain Collateral Assignment and Security Agreement dated June 5, 1992 granting to CII a security interest in certain patents and patent applications of Assignor (the "1992 Security Agreement"), which 1992 Security Agreement was filed with the United States Patent & Trademark Office on August 14, 1992 in Reel 6208 beginning at Frame 0748;

WHEREAS, CII and Gunther entered into an Amendment and Restatement of Development Agreement, dated as of December 31, 1995 (as amended and restated and together with all other related documents and agreements) (hereinafter collectively called the "Development Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant the Development Agreement, CII and Gunther entered into an Amendment to Collateral Assignment and Security Interest, dated as of December 31, 1995 (the "1995 Amendment"), which 1995 Amendment was filed with the United States Patent & Trademark Office on January 30, 1996 in Reel 7779 beginning at Frame 0384,

WHEREAS, under the 1995 Amendment, Gunther granted, assigned and conveyed to CII its entire right, title and interest in and to the patents, trademarks, copyrights and intellectual property listed in Schedule A attached hereto, including without limitation all proceeds thereof, the right to sue for past, present and future infringements, all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world and all reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof and all improvements thereon (collectively called the "Rights") and certain future patents, trademarks, copyrights and intellectual property which were later obtained by Gunther and acquired or created by Gunther (collectively called the "After Acquired Rights"); and

WHEREAS, Assignee has fully performed all of its obligations under the Development Agreement and the Development Agreement has been terminated.

NOW THEREFORE, to all whom it may concern, be it known that for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, (1) CII does hereby grant, assign and convey to Gunther its entire right, title and interest in and to the Rights and After Acquired Rights and (2) CII does hereby terminate and release in full all liens and security interests, including the 1987 Security Agreement and the 1992 Security Agreement,

granted by Gunther in favor of CII and its predecessors in interests. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing contained herein shall be deemed to terminate or otherwise impair those provisions of the Development Agreement which by their express terms survive the termination of the Development Agreement.
