

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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, Richard J. Harp, a United States citizen, residing at 2122 Subida Terrace, Carlsbad, California 92009, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a SURGICAL SYSTEM WITH A BLADE for which I have filed an application for Letters Patent in the United States, Application No. 11/258,841, Filing Date October 25, 2005;

AND WHEREAS, by the terms of the Amended and Restated Employment Agreement dated September 30, 2003 between me and Surgifile, Inc., a California corporation, I acknowledge that said improvements and said Application became the property of Surgifile, Inc.;

AND WHEREAS, SurgiTech, LLC (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), a Delaware limited liability company, with its principal place of business at 1723 Beverly Drive Charlotte, NC 28207, has obtained all of Surgifile's right, title and interest in said improvements and said Application, by the terms of the Overbid Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of September 13, 2007 which was authorized by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court Order dated September 20, 2007 in Bankruptcy No. 06-03702-PB11 (Motion Docket Entry No. 106);

AND WHEREAS, ASSIGNEE desires to clarify its ownership of the entire right, title, and interest in and to said improvements and said Application:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, said inventor, do hereby acknowledge that I have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, my entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in, to and under said improvements, and said application including all provisional applications relating thereto (including but not limited to U.S. Provisional Application Nos. 60/414,690, filed September 27, 2002, 60/621,843, filed October 25, 2004, 60/621,853, filed October 25, 2004 and 60/701,727, filed July 22, 2005), and all divisions, renewals and continuations thereof, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all rights of priority under International Conventions and applications for Letters Patent which may hereafter be filed for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States, and all Letters Patent which may be granted for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof; and I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all Letters Patent for said improvements to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

AND I DO HEREBY sell, assign, transfer, and convey to ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns all claims for damages and all remedies arising out of any violation of the rights assigned hereby that may have accrued prior to the date of assignment to ASSIGNEE, or may accrue hereafter, including, but not limited to, the right to sue for, collect, and retain damages for past infringements of said Letters Patent before or after issuance.

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AND I HEREBY covenant and agree that I will communicate to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to me respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.

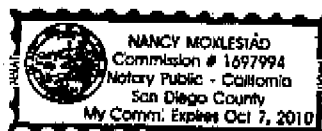
