
NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged:

Assignor hereby further authorizes and requests the U.S. Commissioner of Patents and any relevant patent authority throughout the world to issue any and all patents resulting from the rights assigned hereunder to Assignee, or its successors and assigns, as assignee of Assignor's entire right, title and interest therein.
