ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, **Joseph A. Zahora**, of the City of Oakwood, and State of Ohio, **Xung T. Bui**, of the city of Dayton, and State of Ohio and **Brad S. Bryant** of the City of Xenia, and State of Ohio invented a certain new and useful **CONTROL FOR MULTI-PHASE INDUCTION MOTOR** (Docket No. 533809-00141) for which we executed an application for letters patent of the United States;
