## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, WILLIAM R. SALVESEN, a citizen of the United States, having an address at 7004 Tonnelle Avenue, P.O. Box 227, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047, have invented certain new and useful improvements in DELIVERING FOIL LEAVES OF SELECTED LENGTHS FROM AN INDETERMINATE LENGTH OF FOIL, described in an application for Letters Patent of the United States, executed by me on even date herewith;

SALVESEN**, his successors, legal representatives, and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the said improvements, and the said application and all divisions, renewals and continuations thereof, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all applications for Letters Patent which may hereafter be filed for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States, including the right to claim priority under the terms of any appropriate International Convention based upon said application for Letters Patent of the United States, and all Letters Patent which may be granted for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof; and I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all Letters Patent for said improvements to the said **PETER W. SALVESEN**, his successors, legal representatives, and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

AND I hereby covenant that I have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that I have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND I hereby further covenant and agree that I will communicate to said **PETER W. SALVESEN**, his successors, legal representatives, and assigns, any facts known to me respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute any divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the said **PETER W. SALVESEN**, his successors, legal representatives, and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.
