Re: John W. Booth III's Revocation of Rescission of Assignment of Patents to Sanijet Corporation ("Sanijet") dated November 6, 2009 and Filed of Record with the United States Patent & Trademark Office on December 1, 2009 (the "Rescission")

Gentlemen:


The law firm of James E. Davis, P.C. represents John W. Booth III ("Mr. Booth") and the law firm represents and warrants that Mr. Booth has specifically authorized this firm to act on Mr. Booth's behalf in connection with the matters discussed below. If you have any questions regarding these matters, please feel free to contact me.

As you know, Mr. Booth is the inventor of a "Sanitary Whirlpool Jet Apparatus," as described in and claimed by U.S. Patent No. 5,414,878 dated May 16, 1975, and "A Method of Removing a Whirlpool Jet Apparatus From a Whirlpool Bath for Inspection, Cleaning, or Repair," as described in and claimed by U.S. Patent No. 5,587,023 dated December 24, 1996. Mr. Booth assigned these inventions and the related patents to Sanijet in exchange for Sanijet's promise to pay him a royalty based on the number of jets sold by Sanijet before December 24, 2013. This agreement between Mr. Booth and Sanijet is memorialized in that certain Corrected and Restated Royalty Agreement dated April 15, 2002 (the "Royalty Agreement").

By letter dated November 6, 2009, we advised you of Mr. Booth's unilateral rescission of his previous assignment of his inventions and patents to Sanijet based on the total failure of consideration that was due from Sanijet to Mr. Booth. This letter was filed with the United States Patent & Trademark Office on December 1, 2009.

This letter shall confirm that Ocean Avenue, LLC, Maple Industries, LLC, and Mr. Christopher Jones have reached an agreement with Mr. Booth that resolves all the disputes among them, including the prior dispute between Sanijet and Mr. Booth that gave rise to the Rescission. Thus, this letter also shall confirm that effective this date, Mr. Booth revokes the Rescission and acknowledges Ocean Avenue, LLC owns all rights in and to the above-described technology and patents.

Mr. Booth authorizes Ocean Avenue, LLC to file a true and correct copy of this letter with the United States Patent & Trademark Office in order to memorialize Mr. Booth's revocation of the Rescission.
