XXII, a Delaware corporation (hereinafter the Stock Purchase Agreement) pursuant to Section 3.1.14;

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, effective April 9, 1999, Assignor by these presents does hereby assign, convey, transfer and deliver to Assignee, its successors and assigns, Assignor's entire right, title and interest, for all countries and jurisdictions, along with the right to sue for past infringement to all the Transferred Intellectual Property and any applications or registrations associated therewith.

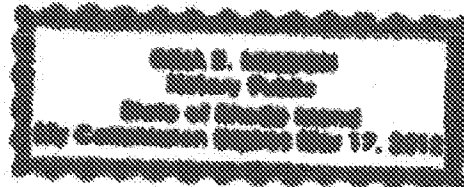

DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT

I, Robert Pereira, declare as follows:

I am the Vice President of Operations for AFC Cable Systems, Inc. I have been an employee of AFC Cable Systems, Inc. since May 8, 1985.

I am aware of U.S. Patent Appln. No. 09/329924 filed June 10, 1999, now issued as U.S. patent 6166329 on December 26, 2000. This patent was assigned by the inventors Michael D. Oliver and Robert A. Proscal to America Cable Systems of New Bedford, Massachusetts on September 14, 2000, the assignment for which was recorded on September 29, 2000, under Reel/Frame 011143/0572.

America Cable Systems is the name of a division used and maintained by AFC Cables Systems, Inc. To the best of my knowledge America Cable Systems has never been registered as a legal entity nor has the name been registered as a DBA of AFC Cable Systems, Inc. However, AFC Cable Systems, Inc. has used and continues to use this division name to sell and distribute products at least as early as 1999 when the above identified matter was filed and prior to the purchase of AFC Cable Systems, Inc., by Tyco International.
