**TERMINATION OF
PATENT SECURITY AGREEMENT**

This TERMINATION OF PATENT SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of June 30, 2010, is by **REGIONS BANK**, in its capacity as Collateral Agent for Lenders, in favor of **STOODY COMPANY**, a Delaware corporation ("Grantor").

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain 2009 Amended and Restated Second Lien Credit Agreement dated as of August 14, 2009 by and among Grantor, the other Persons named therein as Borrowers, Collateral Agent and the Persons signatory thereto from time to time as Lenders and Guarantors (including all exhibits or schedules thereto, and as from time to time amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the "Credit Agreement"), Lenders have made the Loans for the benefit of Grantor and the other Borrowers party thereto;

WHEREAS, Grantor and Collateral Agent for Lenders entered into a certain Patent Security Agreement dated as of August 14, 2009, whereby Grantor grants to Collateral Agent, on behalf of itself and Lenders, a continuing security interest in and mortgage on all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the following, whether presently existing or hereafter created or acquired (collectively, the "Patent Collateral"):

(a) all of its Patents and Patent Licenses together with all registrations and recordings thereof, including, without limitation, applications, registrations and recordings in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or in any similar country or political subdivision thereof, to which it is a party including those referred to on Schedule I hereto;

(b) all reissues, continuations or extensions of the foregoing; and

(c) all products and proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, any claim by Grantor against third parties for past, present or future infringement or dilution of any Patent or any Patent licensed under any Patent License.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Collateral Agent hereby agrees as follows:

1. DEFINED TERMS. All capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in Section 1.01 of the Credit Agreement.

2. TERMINATION OF GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENT COLLATERAL. Collateral Agent acknowledges that the Loans have been paid in full and agrees that the continuing security interest in and mortgage on all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the Patent Collateral is hereby terminated and released.

3. COUNTERPARTS. This Termination of Patent Security Agreement may be authenticated in any number of separate counterparts, each of which shall collectively and separately constitute one agreement. This Termination of Patent Security Agreement may be

authenticated by manual signature, facsimile or, if approved in writing by Grantor, electronic means, all of which shall be equally valid.
