Assignment of Application

Assignor agrees to do, execute and perform such other acts, documents and things as the Assignee may reasonably request in order to give full force and effect to the true meaning and intent of this Assignment, including but not limited to executing such documents as may be necessary or desirable to register, record, perfect or file the assignment of the Application or Patent with public offices and governmental authorities.

4. This Assignment constitutes the entire agreement between the Assignor and the Assignee relating to the subject matter hereof and stands in the place of any previous agreement, whether oral or in writing. No amendment to this Assignment shall be binding upon the parties unless it is in writing and executed by both parties.
5. This Assignment will enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, executors, successor and assigns of the Assignee.

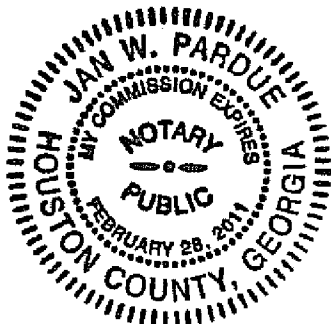
