The University of Utah hereby authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and all authorized officials of foreign patent offices to issue the said Letters Patent, when granted, to The University of Utah Research Foundation as the assignee of its entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for the use and enjoyment of The University of Utah Research Foundation, its successors and assigns.


