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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Trilog Group SARL ("Trilog") and International Business Machines Corporation ("IBM") have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (the "Purchase Agreement") dated August 9, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Trilog has agreed in the Purchase Agreement to sell, assign and transfer all of the FlowBuilder Assets.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment by IBM to Trilog in accordance with the terms of the Purchase Agreement, Trilog hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. All capitalized terms in this Assignment not otherwise defined shall have the meaning given to them in the Purchase Agreement.
2. Trilog hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to IBM all right, title and interest in and to the FlowBuilder Assets, excluding the Other Materials.
3. Trilog hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to IBM all of Trilog's right, title and interest in and to the Other Materials.
4. Trilog hereby waives any and all moral rights associated with the FlowBuilder Assets.
5. Trilog covenants and agrees with IBM to execute and deliver any agreements, acknowledgments and assignments deemed necessary or desirable by IBM to give further effect to this Assignment and the Purchase Agreement and to perfect its title in or registration or evidence ownership of the FlowBuilder Assets in IBM.
