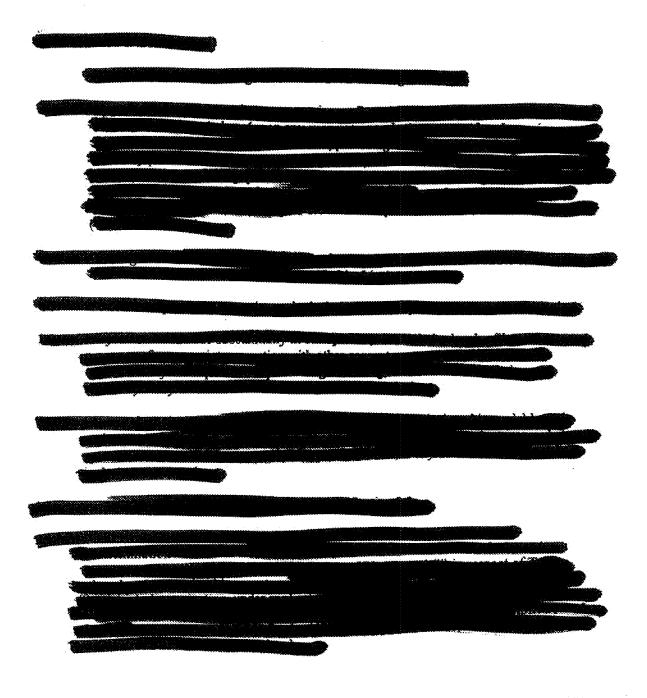

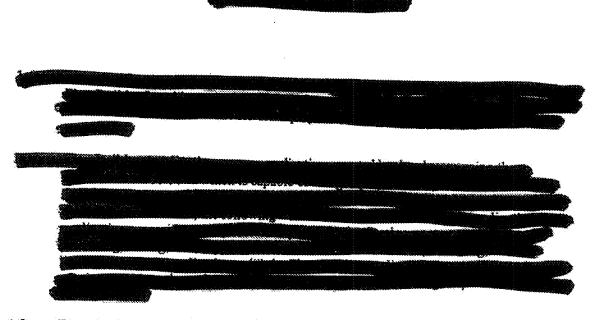
ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT
