ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, the undersigned,

Richard FOX, resident of **Kirkwood, Missouri**;

(referred to hereinafter as "Inventors") have invented certain new and useful improvements in "**METHOD OF GENERATING AN OPTIMIZED, DIVERSE POPULATION OF VARIANTS**" and have filed a U.S. patent application therefor, having Serial No. **12/867,433**, also known as International Application No. **PCT/US2009/033971** and International filing date of **February 12, 2009**, and

2. Said Inventors hereby covenant and agree to cooperate with said Assignee to enable said Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right title and interest herein conveyed in the United States and foreign countries. Such cooperation by said Inventors shall include prompt production of pertinent facts

and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by said Assignee (a) for perfecting in said Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of said applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any said patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said invention and any applications therefor and any patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Inventors in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.

3. The terms and covenants of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Inventors, his/her respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

4. Said Inventors hereby warrants and represents that he/she has not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.


