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**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, We, Jonathan Cedar, being a citizen of the United States of America, having an address at 40 Brite Avenue, Scarsdale, NY 10583 and Alexander H. Drummond, being a citizen of the United States, having an address at 1910 Karen Avenue, Austin, TX 78757, have made new and useful processes, machines, articles of manufacture, compositions of matter, ornamental design and/or improvements in COMBUSTION DEVICE UTILIZING THERMOELECTRICAL GENERATION, for which we have made applications for Letters Patent including U.S. Provisional Application No. 61/103,335, U.S. Non-Provisional Application No. 12/574,647 and International Patent Application No. PCT/US09/59776.

WHEREAS, BioLite LLC, having a place of business at 1430 Rugby Avenue, Charlottesville, VA 22903, and who, together with its successors and assigns ("Assignee") is desirous of acquiring the title, rights, benefits, and privileges hereinafter recited.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration furnished by Assignee to us, receipt and sufficiency of which we hereby acknowledge, we hereby, without reservations:

1. 2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our name or in the name of Assignee or


otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise.

3. Authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct.

4. Bind our heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, as well as ourselves, to do, upon Assignee's request and at Assignee's expense, but without additional consideration to us or them, all acts reasonably serving to assure that the said inventions and discoveries, the said patent applications, and the said Letters Patent shall be held and enjoyed by Assignee as fully and entirely as the same could have been held and enjoyed by us, our heirs, legal representatives, and assigns if this assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to Assignee all lawful application documents including petitions, specifications, and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers, and lawful affidavits in form and substance as may be requested by Assignee; to communicate to Assignee all facts known to us relating to said inventions and discoveries or the history thereof; to furnish Assignee with any and all documents, photographs, models, samples, and other physical exhibits in our control or in the control of our heirs, legal representatives, or assigns which may be useful for establishing the facts of our conception, disclosures, and reduction to practice of said inventions and discoveries; and to testify to the same in any interference, other litigation, or proceeding related thereto.



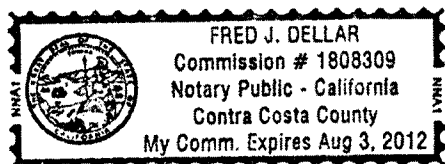
