## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, EIT Technologies N.V., referred to herein as "Assignor", is a limited liability company registered in Curaçao, Netherlands Antilles, located at Kaya W.F.G. (Jombi) Mensing 18 Zeelandia Office Center, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Curaçao, Netherlands Antilles.

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the inventions described in U.S. patent application 632,102, filed on April 15, 1996, now U.S. Patent No. 5,828,837, entitled "Computer Network System and Method for Efficient Information Transfer" that was issued by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on October 27, 1998, and U.S. patent application 832,687, filed on April 11, 1997, now U.S. Patent No. 5,768,508, entitled "Computer Network System and Method for Efficient Information Transfer" issued by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on June 16, 1998, which is a continuation-in-part of U.S. application 632,102 (collectively referred to as "the Patents").

WHEREAS, EIT Holdings LLC, referred to herein as "Assignee", is a limited liability company registered in Delaware, located at 2711 Centerville Road, Suite 400, Wilmington, DE 19808.



FURTHER, Assignor warrants that Assignor has full right to convey the interests assigned, and that Assignor has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict with this Assignment; and Assignor hereby further warrants that Assignor will execute all confirmatory assignments, instruments and documents, and will perform such other and further acts to cause any and all of said Patents to be issued to Assignee, its successors and assigns, as Assignee or its designees reasonably request in order to give effect to the provisions of this Assignment.

Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner for Patents of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of intellectual property protection on applications for such protection, to issue the same to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.

This is the entire agreement between the parties concerning its subject matter. It will be interpreted and construed in accordance with its fair meaning and not for or against either party.
