ASSIGNMENT OF APPLICATION FOR LETTERS PATENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF APPLICATION FOR LETTERS PATENT (this "Assignment") is made this 10th day of December, 2010, by and between Carl F. Booth & Co., LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Assignor"), and Goodrich Corporation, a New York corporation (the "Assignee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Assignor and the Assignee are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of August 3, 2010 (the "Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which the Assignor agreed to assign to the Assignee all of the Assignor's right, title and interest in, to and under the patents and patent applications included in the Purchased Assets (as defined in the Purchase Agreement), including the patent application set forth on Schedule A (the "Patent"); and

The Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers unto the Assignee its entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent and all letters patent in all countries of the world based thereon or corresponding thereto, and all divisional, continuing, continuation-in-part, renewal, substitute and reissue applications therefor, including any applications that claim priority thereto, and the patents which may be thereupon issued, including any and all rights to file applications and receive patents in all countries of the world, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee to the full end of the term for which said letters patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor had this assignment and sale not been made; and the Assignor hereby agrees to sign all necessary papers and do all lawful acts reasonably requisite in connection with the prosecution, assignment, enforcement and disclaimer of each and every patent application based upon the Patent, without further compensation, but at the expense of the Assignee or its successors and assigns, and the Assignor assigns to the Assignee all rights to sue for infringement, including past infringement if any, of any Patent or patent based upon or corresponding to the Patent.

2. The Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the officials of all countries in which the Patent is now or in the future will be issued to issue to the Assignee all of Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to the same for the sole use and enjoyment of the Assignee, its successors and assigns.

3. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
