## TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS

This **TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS**, dated as of December 9, 2010, is made by PNC Bank, National Association, as Agent (the "Secured Party").

**WHEREAS**, Para-Chem Southern, Inc. (the "Grantor") has granted a security interest in certain personal property to the Secured Party, including without limitation a security interest in certain Patent Collateral (as hereinafter defined);

The Secured Party hereby terminates, discharges, relinquishes and releases any and all mortgages, liens, and security interests it acquired in (i) the United States Letters Patent and the inventions described and claimed therein set forth on Schedule A hereto and any future patents of the Grantor (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Patents"); (ii) the applications for Letters Patent and the inventions described and claimed therein set forth on Schedule A hereto and any United States Letters Patent which may be issued upon any of said applications and any future patent applications of the Grantor (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Applications"); (iii) any reissue, reexamination, extension, substitution, division or continuation of the Patents or the Applications (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Reissue Patents"); (iv) all future royalties or other fees paid or payment or payments made or to be made to the Grantor in respect of the Patents (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Royalties"); (v) proceeds of any and all of the foregoing (such proceeds together with the Patents, Applications, Reissue Patents, and Royalties hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Patent Rights"); and (vi) all rights, interests, claims and demands that the Grantor has or may have in existing and future profits and damages for past, present, and future infringements of the Patent Rights (such rights, interests, claims and demands being herein called the "Claims")(the Patent Rights and Claims herein collectively referred to as the "Patent Collateral").
2. Grantor shall cause this Termination of Security Interest in Patents to be filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office for the purpose of recording the release of the security interest granted to Secured Party.
3. This Termination of Security Interest in Patents shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
