Assignor warrants that it owns the patents, patent applications and inventions identified herein, has the right and power to enter into this Assignment, is aware of no other party claiming any ownership or use rights in any of the Patent Assets, knows of no other arrangement, agreement or information inconsistent with or in conflict with this Patent Assignment and agrees not to participate in any of the same in the future.

Assignor hereby authorizes and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and other authorities in foreign countries to issue any and all patents on said Inventions or resulting from said Application and from any and all related regular and other patent applications, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and reissues thereof, to Assignee, as assignee of our entire interest.
